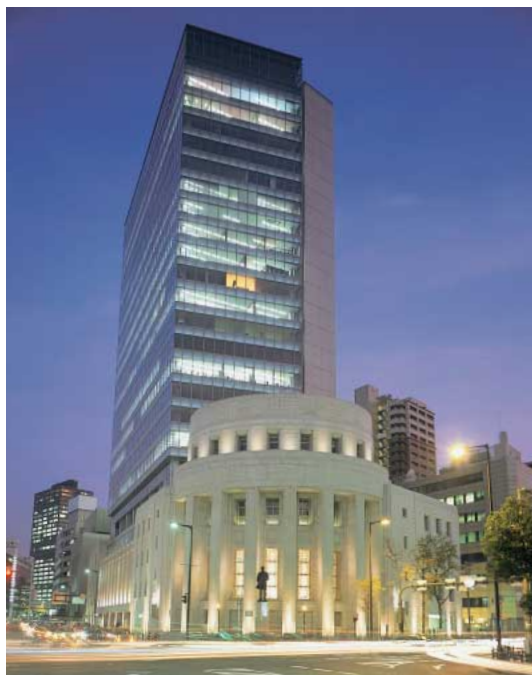

Osaka Securities Exchange Building

Osaka, Japan



The old Osaka Securities Building (Shijokan), which had long been familiar as a main feature of Kitahama, the heart of the commercial city of Osaka, has been renovated as the Osaka Securities Exchange Building. With the front gate and part of the outside walls of the old 1935 building retained, a 24-story modern office building has been newly completed.

Suitably matched with the state-of-the-art building, Fujitec installed six high-speed elevators traveling up to 210 mpm. The elevator landing doors are provided with semi-transparent tapestry mirror glass panels with a specially treated surface, creating a high-class and sophisticated image.
